ADULTS WITHOUT CHILDREN**Compass Center**

This agency maintains multiple sites and programs.

Each program has its own intake procedure and waitlist, if applicable.

Compass Cascade.....206.357.3150
Serves single women, with an income of less than 30% of the area median (\$1450) . Rent is 30% of income, no one will be refused for inability to pay.

Long Term Transitional Housing.....206.357.3266
Serves single men and women. Rent is 30% of income plus a fee for misc. items. Refundable deposit required. Houses are located in North Seattle Must be willing to make six month commitment.

Pioneer Square206.357.3250
Screens on Tu and F, 1pm. Sobriety required. Serves men, ages 18+ with annual income below 30% of area median. Rent is 30% of income, plus misc. fees. No one is refused for inability to pay.

Veterans Transitional Housing

- Shoreline.....206.357.3280
Serves male and female veterans of U.S. military who completed term of service with a better than dishonorable discharge. Private rooms with shared bathrooms and common areas. Income must be less than 30% of area median. Rent is 30% of income, plus \$50 deposit.

Vietnam Veterans Leadership Program ..206.357.3263
Housing is located in two large single-family style houses, one in Seattle's Columbia City, and one in Burien. Must be willing and able to work. Serves male veterans with a better than dishonorable discharge. Rent is 30% of income plus \$10 for misc. items. \$50 refundable deposit.

M-F; 9am-5pm. Serves families and individuals. Families must have a shelter referral; individuals w/out children may self refer.

Jubilee Women's Center206.324.1244
Serves single women, age 18+. Houses are in Capitol Hill neighborhood. Must be 6 months clean and sober. Residents must either be working, volunteering, or in school with a steady source of income. Rent is \$200-\$275 for a single room, reduced rates for those receiving GAU/X.

ADULTS WITHOUT CHILDREN**Overlake Christian Church**

Serves non-parenting, pregnant women, ages 18+. Agency has a pro-life philosophy. Church attendance is required. Clients have individual bedrooms with shared bathroom and living area. If keeping the baby, women may stay two months after giving birth. If baby is adopted, women may stay six months after birth. Sliding-scale fees: \$0-\$150. Women may work service hours in lieu of rent. Maintains a waitlist.

SHARE/WHEEL206.448.7889
Operates 3 transitional housing sites in S Seattle. Serves single adults and couples. Screening is conducted in-person on Saturdays at noon. Call after 4pm on Thursday for information on where the Saturday meeting is being held. \$60/month for utilities. Housing is free in exchange for work in SHARE/WHEEL programs. Does not maintain a waitlist.

Sojourner Place206.545.4200
Serves single women without children and pregnant women. Pregnant women may stay 3 months after giving birth. Must be 3 months clean and sober, if in recovery. Must be working, in job training, or volunteering. Rent is \$290/month for a shared room, \$365 for a private room. Rent includes room, food, utilities, phone and internet access, and laundry.

United States Mission.....206.701.9113
Serves men and women, ages 18+. Must be willing and able to work. Self-help work program is required of all residents; work is paid so clients can establish a savings. Agency does not proselytize; no religious components are required. Provides 2 meals a day. No fees.

CLEAN AND SOBER / RECOVERY HOUSING**Catholic Community Services**

Katherine's House.....253.856.4416
Clean and sober housing for single women, ages 18+. Must be clean for 30 days prior to entry. Priority given to women involved in the criminal justice system. May accept pregnant women, usually in 1st/2nd trimester. Rent is 30% of income; \$100 minimum.

Rita's House.....253.833.5271
Serves women 18+. Must be 30-6- days clean and sober and enrolled in outpatient treatment program. May accept pregnant women; usually in 1st/2nd trimester. Rent is 30% of monthly income; \$100 minimum.

CLEAN AND SOBER / RECOVERY HOUSING**Union Gospel Mission**

NOT a state-certified chemical dependency program. Do not have to have time clean and sober when entering program, but must have a desire to be drug/alcohol free. Participation in 12-step programs is required. Focus on relapse prevention, ending self-destructive behaviors, and growth in faith. Serves men, 18+.

1808 18th Ave, Seattle
Comprehensive residential treatment for chemical dependency. 1 year program. Includes counseling, life skills training, relapse prevention. Enrollment in 12-step program required. Program is Christian based, but no religious belief is required. Located in Capitol Hill. Serves men, ages 18+.

3020 S 128th St, Seattle
WA State certified Chemical Dependency Program. Nine month program. Required participation in work therapy and Bible study. Serves men, ages 18+.

Vision House425.228.6356
Group housing in Burien and Renton. Must be clean at least 28 days prior to program entry. Zero-tolerance relapse policy. Serves men, 18+, who have completed a drug treatment program. Rent is 30% of monthly income.

Victory Outreach Church

Christian-based home. Serves single and married adults who have a desire to change their lifestyle. 9-12 months commitment is required. Sliding scale fees: \$0-\$250.
